VNU operates under a high degree of autonomy and accountability, working directly with ministries, ministerial-level agencies, government agencies, and provincial or municipal People's Committees on matters related to its activities and development.

Member universities and research institutes under VNU are autonomous institutions with legal status equivalent to other universities and scientific research institutes as stipulated by the Law on Education, the Law on Higher Education, the Law on Amendments and Supplements to a Number of Articles of the Law on Higher Education, and the Law on Science and Technology.

In 2006, on the occasion of the 100th anniversary of the founding of the University of Indochina – the predecessor of VNU, the university was honored to receive the Gold Star Order, the highest decoration awarded by the Party and the State, recognizing its significant contributions to the cause of national construction and defense.

VNU possesses the largest and most prominent team of scientists within Vietnam's higher education system. Currently, it has nearly 5,500 staff members and lecturers, including many leading scientists with prestigious reputations domestically and internationally, covering fields such as natural sciences, social sciences and humanities, foreign languages, technology, economics, law, education, and more.




SUPPORT FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS AT VNU

Guiding circulars: Circular No. 04/2015/TT-BCA and Circular No. 57/2020/TT-BCA, issued by the Ministry of Public Security (on application forms, residence documents, visas, and temporary residence).



- Study the program you are admitted to and enjoy the same academic rights as all VNU stúdents.
- → Receive guidance and support regarding academic procedures, daily life, and campus services.
- Access campus facilities, including libraries, study spaces, sports areas, and student services.
- Join cultural, artistic, sports activities and student clubs organized by VNU and its member universities.
- Take part in research projects, workshops, seminars, and academic events. Enjoy official holidays and personal leave in accordance with Vietnamese regulations; family visits are allowed according to visa rules.
- Students under scholarship or exchange programs may receive additional benefits depending on program agreements.

- Respect Vietnamese laws, university rules, local culture, and community norms.
- Follow all academic regulations regarding study, examination, attendance, and conduct.
- Comply with immigration regulations, including visa, residence registration, and travel reporting.
- ◆ Take care of campus property and contribute to a positive, friendly, and respectful learning environment.
- Complete required health insurance, residence registration, and fulfill financial obligations as required by the program.

VIETNAM'S WEATHER AND CLIMATE GUIDE

Vietnam has a tropical monsoon climate, which means it is generally hot, humid, and rainy. However, because the country stretches from north to south, the weather in each region is quite different.

In the North, there are four distinct seasons: spring, summer, autumn, and winter. Summers are hot and humid with a lot of rain, while winters can be cold and dry, especially in the mountains, where temperatures may drop below 10°C.

The Central region has a harsher climate. The northern part of Central Vietnam has a cool winter like the North, while the southern part is hot all year round. From September to November, this area often experiences heavy rains and storms, sometimes causing floods.

The South has a typical tropical climate with two main seasons: the rainy season (May to November) and the dry season (December to April). The temperature stays warm year-round, usually between 25–35°C.



Tips for Students

- → Bring warm clothes if visiting the North in winter
- ♦ Umbrella or raincoat for rainy season
- → Sunscreen and light clothes for hot weather

TIPS FOR ??

- Take your time and look both ways when crossing.
- Use Google Maps to help you find the best route.
- Carry small cash for bus and metro fares.
- Only drive a motorbike if you're confident and have a valid license.

1. Public Buses

Cheap and reliable for longer distances.

Use the BusMap app for routes and schedules.

Ticket: 7,000 - 12,000 VND per ride

Monthly pass available (from 100,000 VND)

2. Metro

New, clean, and easy to use Line 2A (Cát Linh – Hà Đông is currently operating Ticket: 8,000–15,000 VND Monthly pass available (from 100,000 VND)

3. Motorbike Taxis (Grab, Be, Xanh SM)

Fast and convenient for short trips.

Always check the fare in the app before booking.

4. Taxi

Safer but more expensive than bikes.
Recommended companies: Mai Linh, Vinasun, G7

Ask drivers to turn on the meter.

5. Walking & Biking

Great for exploring the Old Quarter. Be cautious: sidewalks may be crowded, and traffic is busy.

BANKING & PAYMENTS



1. Opening a Bank Account

Easy for international students with passport, visa, and student ID.
Popular banks: Vietcombank, BIDV,
Techcombank, VPBank, MB Bank,...
Useful for receiving money and paying tuition/rent.

2. Cash & ATMs

Vietnam is still cash-based, so keep small bills for daily expenses. ATMs are everywhere; check withdrawal fees before using.

3. E-wallets

Convenient for cashless payments in stores, cafes, and online shopping. You need a Vietnamese bank account to fully activate most e-wallets.

Most common apps:

- Momo: e-wallet for bills, food delivery, tickets, phone top-ups,...
- ZaloPay: linked to Zalo (popular chat app in Vietnam).
- **♦ VNPay:** QR payments in many shops.
- Apple Pay: works with international bank cards, accepted at some cafés, supermarkets, and retail stores.
- GrabPay: integrated with Grab for rides and food.
- ShopeePay: ntegrated with Grab for rides and food.

Tips for Students

- Always check your receipt before paying.
- Be careful when sharing card or account details.
- Keep some cash as backup, especially in local markets or street food stalls.



HEALTH CARE AND SAFETY

1. Healthcare Services

- Hospitals & Clinics: Vietnam offers public, private, and international hospitals with English-speaking support.
- Student health insurance is strongly recommended.
- Bring personal medicines and prescriptions when you first arrive.

2. Staying Healthy

- Drink bottled or boiled water. Wash hands often, especially before eating.
- Be cautious with street food choose clean, busy stalls.
- Wear masks during flu season or when air quality is poor.
- Stay hydrated in hot weather and wear sunscreen.

3. Personal Safety

- Keep valuables in a safe place; avoid carrying large amounts of cash.
- Watch out for pickpockets, especially in crowded areas.
- Cross the street carefully traffic can be unpredictable.
- Use Grab or reliable taxis at night.

VIETNAMESE CUISINE

For breakfast, there are many options such as bún (vermicelli noodles), phổ, sticky rice, or bread. International students usually adapt quickly to Vietnamese food.

Meals are available at the university canteen for around 35,000 VND per meal, or at local eateries (com bình dân) for 30,000 - 60,000 VND on average.

Must-try Vietnamese specialties: nem (spring rolls), bún chả (grilled pork with vermicelli), bánh chưng (sticky rice cake), and phả (Vietnamese noodle soup).




